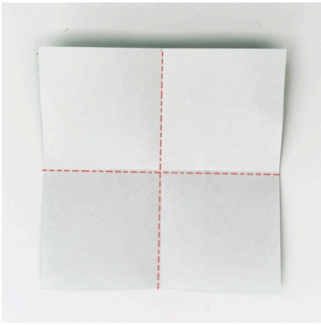
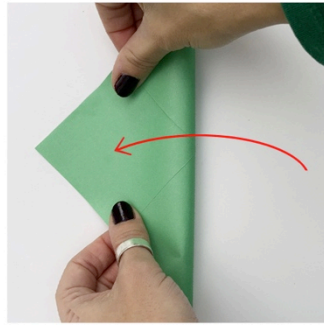


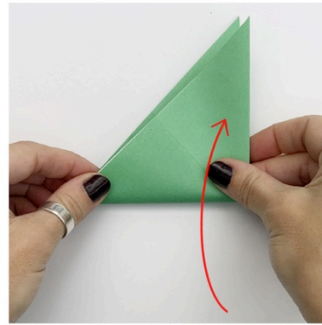
Origami Christmas Tree



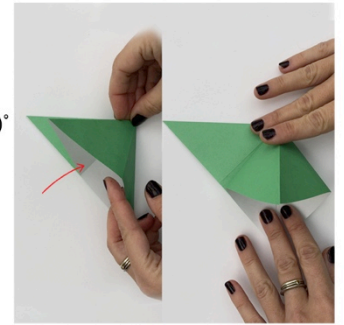
1. With the coloured side down fold and unfold your paper into quarters.



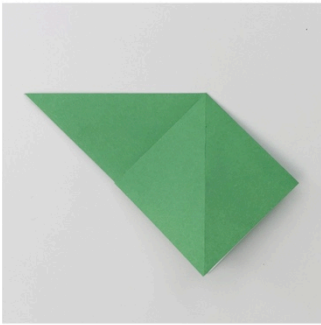
2. Turn paper by 45°. Fold in half diagonally



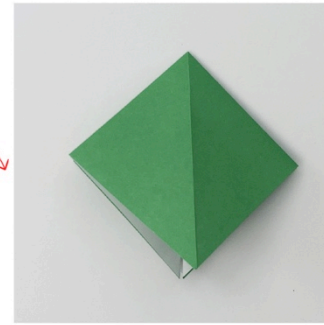
3. Fold in half again. You will have a small right-angle triangle. Swivel by 90°.



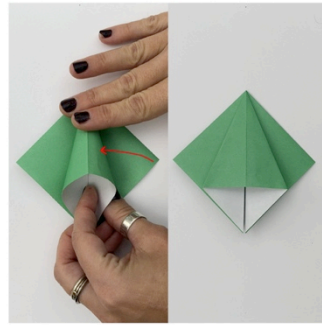
4. Lift the top flap up, start to open the paper out and squash into a diamond.



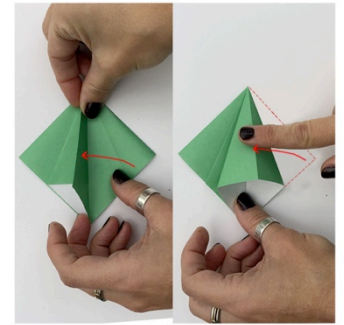
5 It will look like this. Turn paper over.



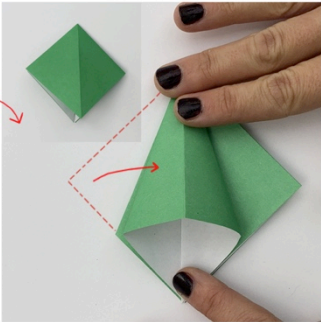
6. Repeat step 4.



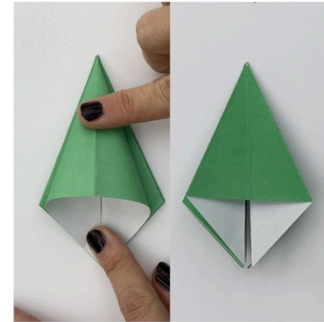
7. Lift the right flap up along the middle fold. Squash it down, ensuring centre creases align.



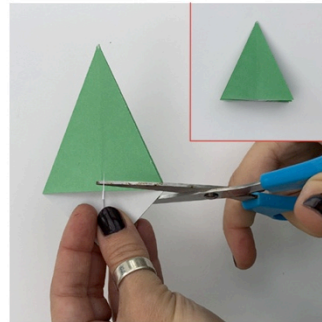
8. Fold this piece to the left like turning the page of a book. Repeat step 7 with the next flap.



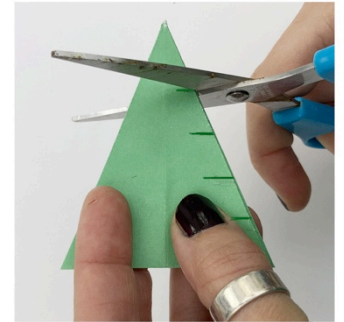
9. Turn paper over and repeat step 7



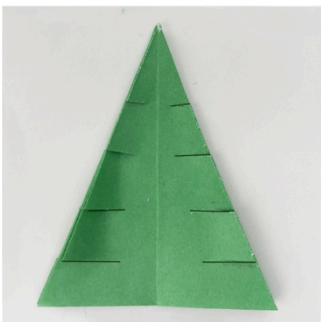
10. Repeat step 8.



11. Cut off the bottom triangle.



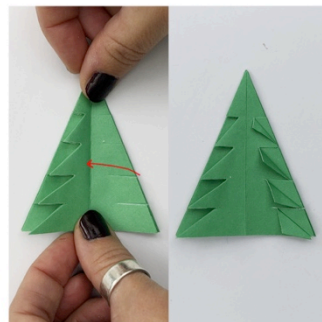
12. On the right side make 4 equally spaced cuts through all layers. Don't cut too close to the centre crease. Leave at least 2mm.



13. Repeat on the other side.



14. On the right side of your model, fold between the cuts diagonally. Only fold through 1 flap at a time.



15. Fold the flap to the left and, on the right side, continue to fold between the cuts.



16. Repeat steps 14 and 15 until you have completed 4 layers.



17. Turn the model over. Repeat steps 14 -16.



18. Stand the tree upright and equally space the flaps.
