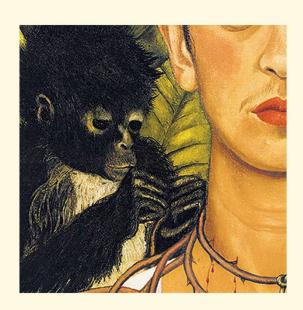
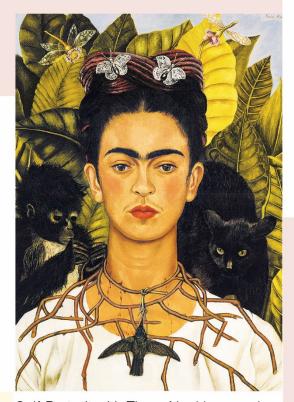
East Kent Schools TOGETHER
