A Finished Piece

A self-portrait using symbolism.

- Your symbol should be an object or animal that symbolises something that connected you to the outside world during lockdown.
- Your finished piece can be any size you like.
- You can use any medium, but your piece should be able to be hung on a wall (i.e. not a sculpture).
- Photography can be used as a starting point, but should not be the main medium.



An Ideas board

A board showing the development of your final piece. This might include:

- Your Postcard
- Artist studies
- Sketches of your lockdown symbol
- Self-portrait studies
- Photographs
- Trials in different media
- Notes

A Short Video Presentation

A short film up to 2 minutes in length. You can film it on a mobile phone. We would like to know:

- Your name and school.
- Which artists have inspired your work?
- What is your lockdown symbol and why did you choose it?
- What medium have you used and why?
- Does your piece have a title?
- Anything else you would like to tell us!
